Negatives To Avoid: Bitterness, uncontrolled anger, hatred, envy, jealousy, selfishness, pride, discontent	<b>Gal 5:19-21</b>
Positives to Cultivate: Forgiveness, tolerance, patience, love, kindness, thoughtfulness, self-control, godliness	<b>Gal 5:22-23</b>
<i>Practices That Take Us Forward &amp; Build An Excellent Witness For Jesus</i>	
Actively using our gifts/talents to help others with their physical and/or spiritual needs	<b>Gal 6:2</b>
Becoming faithful with our tithes and offerings to support God's work as good stewards	<b>Mal 3:8-12</b>
Exercising a separation from the world so that God will receive us unto Himself	<b>Eph 4:17-24</b>
Ceasing our use of tobacco and alcoholic beverages; not misusing drugs; avoiding gluttony	<b>I Cor 6:12</b>
Making sure our media choices (listening, viewing, reading, computer/internet) reflect and enhance our Christian walk	<b>Ps 101:3</b>
Making sure the places we go and the things we attend are consistent with Christ-like values	<b>II Cor 6:14-18</b>
Dressing modestly, decently, and appropriately without drawing attention to ourselves with jewelry or expensive clothing	<b>I Tim 2:9</b>
Refraining from becoming a busybody - minding our own business - sowing encouragement, not discord	<b>Prov 6:16-19</b>
Avoiding bragging or elevating ourselves in our own eyes or to others – instead, cultivating humility & meekness	<b>I Pet 5:5</b>
Respecting authority and cooperating with leaders in their area of responsibility	<b>I Cor 16:16</b>
Staying loyal to our pastor, church, and brothers and sisters in Christ	<b>Eph 4:32</b>
Refraining from the use of profanity, slander, or off-color, racially or ethnically biased language or jokes	<b>Eph 4:29-31</b>
Always respecting and practicing truthfulness, honesty, morality and legality	<b>Eph 4:25</b>
Never placing ourselves or others in a morally compromising situation	<b>Eph 5:3-18</b>
<i>Where Men &amp; Women Take a Separate Road</i>
