| <b>(4<sup>th</sup>)</b> | <b>We are to set aside at least one day / week for the Lord,<br/>... and not get so busy or distracted that we do not have time for it.</b>                             | <b>(Hebrews 10:25)</b>         |
| <b>(5<sup>th</sup>)</b> | <b>We are to respect and care for our parents,<br/>... and not speak badly of them or allow them to become destitute.</b>   | <b>(Matthew 15:4-6)</b>        |
| <b>(6<sup>th</sup>)</b> | <b>We are to love our enemies,<br/>... and not seek vengeance or commit murder against them.</b>  | <b>(Matthew 5:44-48)</b>       |
| <b>(7<sup>th</sup>)</b> | <b>We are to remain committed to sexual purity through marriage of one man to one woman,<br/>... and not commit adultery or participate in fornication of any kind.</b> | <b>(1 Corinthians 6:15-20)</b> |
| <b>(8<sup>th</sup>)</b> | <b>We are to work so that we can give to those who are in need,<br/>... and not steal from others or take inappropriate advantage of them.</b>                          | <b>(Ephesians 4:28)</b>        |
| <b>(9<sup>th</sup>)</b> | <b>We are to speak the truth in love,<br/>... and not tell lies about or misrepresent ourselves or others.</b>  | <b>(Ephesians 4:14-15)</b>     |
